You can apply for a primary school place in England between September 2026 and 15 January 2027.

Reminder

Collection and Drop Off: – A reminder that the cut off time for dropping off in the morning is 10.30am and 2.00pm in the afternoon so please therefore let us know if your child is going to be in later than these times as our cook needs to know numbers for lunches and tea. Also, if your child's session finishes at 1pm please be here by 1pm and no later as we have children who start at that time, so the morning session children need to have left by then. If you are late, the staff will not be able to give you feedback about your child as they need to be back in the room for the afternoon session. This also applies to children whose session finishes at 6pm; please pick them up by 6pm as the nursery closes at that time and again staff will not be able to give you feedback about your child.
